Paul Hinzpeter Chairman, Golf Committee Inside the church, you will see refurbished original paintings of the 12 apostles from the early 1900's which adorn the ceiling of the church nave, along with pictures of Jesus and Mary above the sanctuary. The large sanctuary lamp dating from 1890 was added as part of the restoration. Behind the main altar are five large stained glass windows representing Our Lord and the four evangelists - Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

Parish History

In keeping with the Greek style architecture, there are no statues in the main portion of the church. At the front of the nave just inside the communion rail, are two imposing mosaics of Jesus and Mary created circa 1850.

# **Parish History**

#### A Brief History of St. Mary's Assumption in Lafayette Square

This beautiful Gothic church built in the early 1860's, has watched the area change many times. Originally an Episcopal church, it was purchased by Ruthenian Greek Catholics in 1902. In 1896, a tornado destroyed some of the building and most of the huge bell tower. The bell tower was never rebuilt. In 1942, the sanctuary was endowed with a Romanesque baldachino (canopy) over the freestanding altar. In the recent past, the church has been home to several Protestant and nondenominational groups.

St. Mary's Assumption, which seats 300, was obtained by the Society of St. Pius X in 1996 and renovated. The oak pews and parquet floor have been restored to their original condition and tuck-pointing and roof repairs have been made. The house across the parking lot to the north of the church has also been completely renovated, and serves as the parish rectory.

The original Stations of the Cross were lost through the years. The beautiful Stations presently in the church, dating from the 1880s, were saved from St. Ann's Church and Shrine and preserved in storage until they were again resurrected to a place of honor at St. Mary's Assumption.



Tournament Rules

#### Four Person Scramble Format

USGA rules apply.

Shotgun Start.

All men hit from white tees. All women hit from red tees. Seniors (60+) may hit from the blue tees (except for contest holes).

All players must hit a tee shot.

Players continue to select the best ball. Each player hits until the ball is holed.

Two Putt Rule: Do not tap in your putt because ball is deemed to be holed. Wait until all players have a turn to putt.

Mulligans: Mulligans cannot be used for any contest.

Handmashies: This allows one member of the team to pick up the ball anywhere on the course and throw it closer to the hole. This will not count as a stroke. (A good place to use a Handmashie is right off the green.) One Handmashie is allowed per 9 holes and cannot be used for any special competitions..

NOTE: At least one person from each foursome should download the "Golf Genius" app before teeing off!
